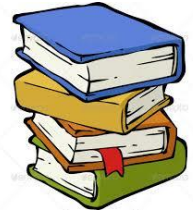

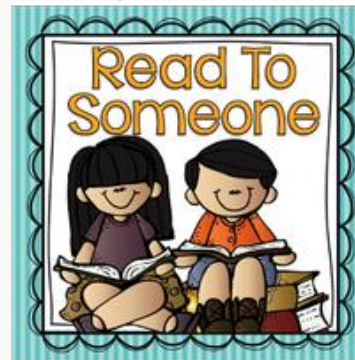


Welcome to the Pleasant Hill Library!

Your child will have the opportunity to explore the wonderful world of books one day each week in our Media Center. Here are some suggestions and information to help you and your child with this library experience.

You can help develop a love of reading by enjoying the books with your child. Many of the books for primary aged children are best enjoyed by you reading them to your child. Other books that he picks may be at the appropriate reading level, so encourage your student to read to you.

You can also share read to show him your enthusiasm.



Please remind your child to have clean hands and avoid snacks when reading library books, use a bookmark to mark her place, and turn the page from the upper corner. Damaged books must be replaced.

It helps to have a specific place to keep the library books. It's a good idea to return it to her backpack after it's been read.
